VENUE

Conference Venue

The WCC will take place at Centre Inria de Paris (48 rue Barrault, 75013 Paris). The conference venue is located in the 13th arrondissement, in the charming and lively neighborhood known as “La Butte-aux-Cailles”. This area is well known for its village-like atmosphere, offering a pleasant setting while remaining easily accessible from the rest of the city.



The conference venue is conveniently served by public transportation, with several metro stations located within walking distance:

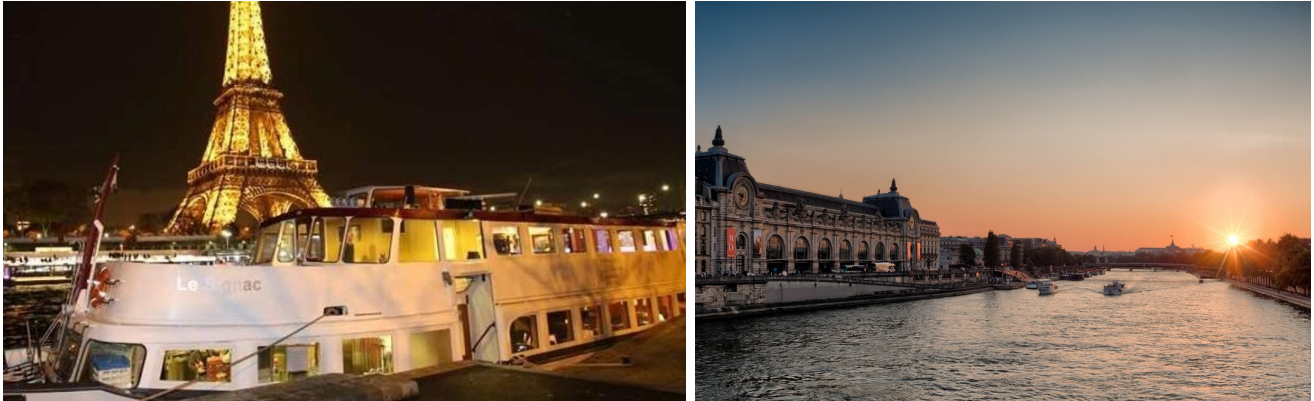
- Corvisart (line 6) - walk of 7mn to Inria

Gala Dinner

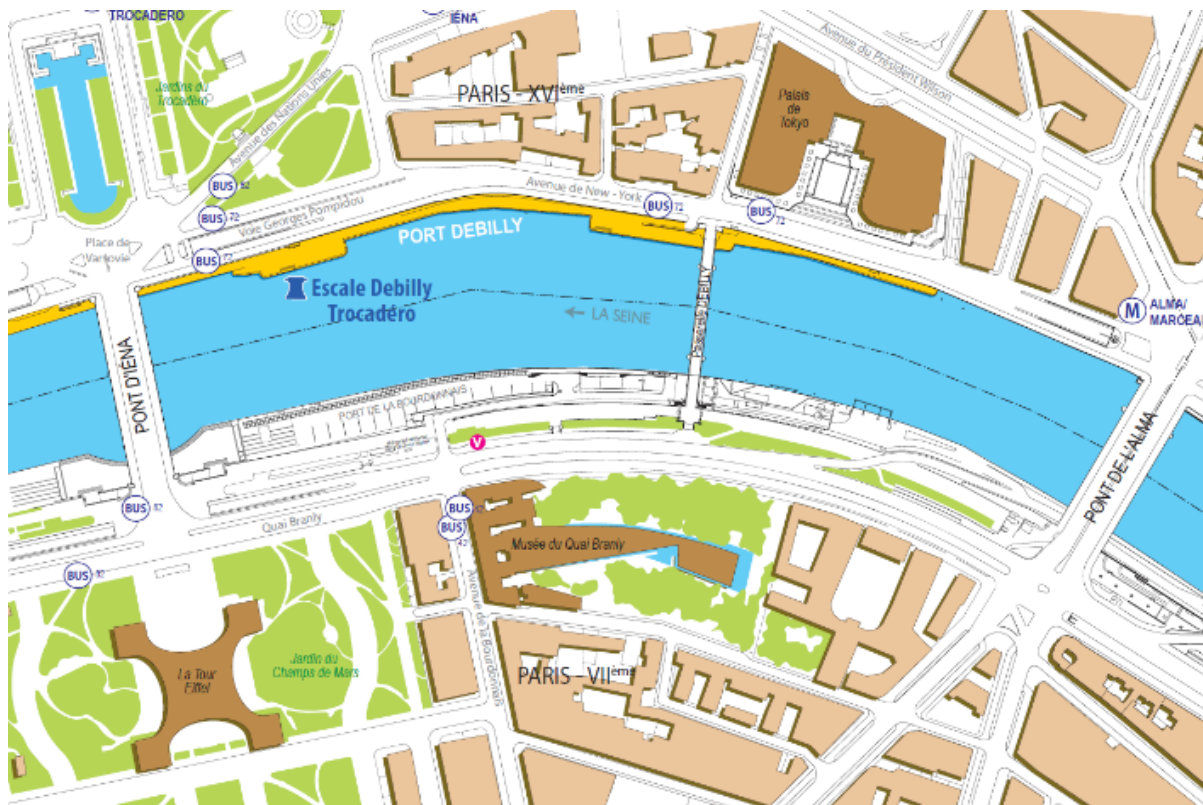

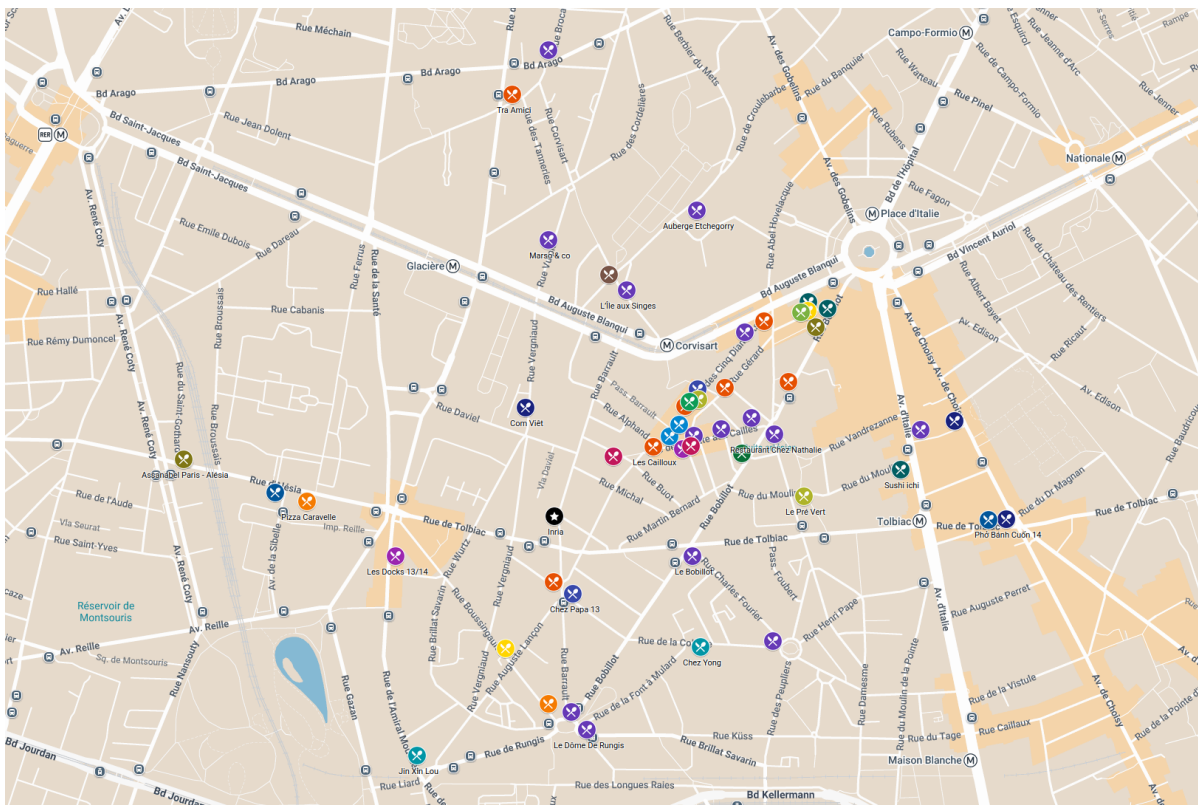

Map of Restaurants

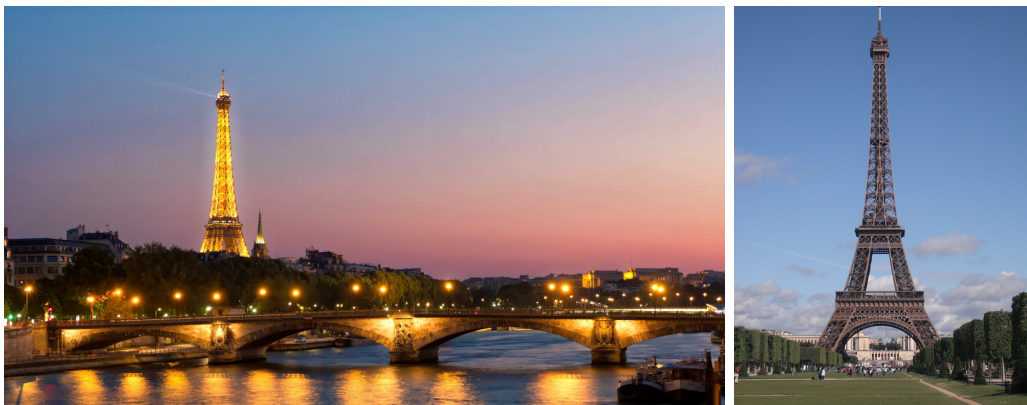


VISITING PARIS

As the heart of France, Paris remains one of the world's great hubs for culture and discovery. With its deep history and stunning architecture, the city is alive with museums and a creative spirit that makes it feel both timeless and constantly evolving.

Tour Eiffel

Paris's monumental landscape is marked by iconic structures, foremost among which is the Eiffel Tower, built for the 1889 World's Fair, which remains a major benchmark in engineering to this day.



Notre-Dame de Paris

In the immediate vicinity, the Île de la Cité, the historic cradle of the capital, is home to Notre-Dame Cathedral, whose Gothic architecture illustrates the artistic and technical excellence of the Middle Ages.



Musée du Louvre

Paris's museums occupy a central position in the global cultural landscape. The Louvre Museum, a former royal palace, houses collections of exceptional scope and diversity, spanning several millennia and cultural regions.



Musée d'Orsay

The Musée d'Orsay, housed in a converted former railway station, offers a definitive overview of 19th-century artistic movements, particularly Impressionism.



Montmartre

Furthermore, certain neighbourhoods contribute to the unique character of Paris's urban fabric. Montmartre retains a distinct historical and artistic character, enhanced by the presence of the Sacré-Cœur Basilica, which overlooks the city and offers a panoramic view of it.



Arc-de-Triomphe

Major urban features, such as the axis formed by the Champs-Élysées linking the Place de la Concorde to the Arc de Triomphe, reflect a desire for order and perspective that is characteristic of Parisian urban planning.



Jardin du Luxembourg

Finally, landscaped spaces, such as the Jardin du Luxembourg or the Jardin des Tuileries, play a vital role in the city's balance by offering breathing spaces within a dense urban environment.

Transportation

Arriving in Paris from Airports

From Charles de Gaulle Airport (CDG). The RER B train is the most common connection to the city center, but be cautious: this line is frequently affected by maintenance and modernization works, especially on weekends or late at night, which can lead to partial closures or replacement buses. We strongly recommend checking the real-time traffic information before traveling.

If you are carrying heavy luggage or prefer a simpler and more comfortable journey, **official taxis are highly recommended**. Follow the signs marked “Taxi” to reach the official taxi queue outside the terminal.

Do not accept rides from people approaching you inside the airport,
as these are unauthorized drivers and often overcharge passengers.

From Orly Airport (ORY). Metro Line 14 is now the fastest and easiest way to reach central Paris, with direct access in about 25 minutes. Official taxis are also available directly outside the terminals and provide a convenient alternative, especially with luggage.

Navigating in Paris

The Paris Metro remains the fastest and most efficient way to move around the city, with stations located every few hundred meters. Traditional paper tickets have essentially disappeared. The easiest solution for visitors is to use the official **Bonjour RATP** smartphone application, which allows you to:

- buy Metro/RER/bus tickets directly on your phone,
- store and validate tickets digitally,
- check routes and real-time traffic information.

If your phone is not compatible, you can instead purchase a **Navigo Easy** card. This reusable contactless pass costs about 2 € and can be topped up at ticket machines, station counters, or with your smartphone. It is particularly convenient for short stays.

Paris also offers an extensive bicycle-sharing system called **Vélib'**. Both regular bicycles (green color) and electric bicycles (blue color) are available throughout the city. Stations can be found almost everywhere, and bikes can be unlocked either:

- directly with the Vélib' mobile application,
- or using a short-term pass purchased online or at station terminals.

Electric bikes cost slightly more than regular ones but are very convenient for longer rides or hilly areas such as Montmartre.
